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Champions Race
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Johnson-Norval Upset Local Hopes in Battle of Bangalore

BANGALORE, India—In bright sunshine in front of a packed house at the Karnataka State Lawn Tennis Association Tennis Center in Bangalore, the American-South African duo of Don Johnson and Piet Norval became World Doubles Champions after defeating local heroes Mahesh Bhupathi and Leander Paes.

It was not to be third time lucky for Bhupathi and Paes, who lost their third World Doubles Final in four years. Johnson-Norval avenged their

defeat by the Indian duo in the round robin stage to record a 7-6(8), 6-3, 6-4 victory in 2 hours, 18 minutes.

The result was a disappointment for the 7,500 home fans who roared Bhupathi-Paes on to no avail, and for the many thousands of Indians who turned out throughout the week to cheer their sporting heroes at the

Gold Flake/ATP Tour World Doubles Championship.

After being presented with the trophy by the Honorable Chief Minister of the State of Karnataka, and also President of the KSLTA, Shri S.M. Krishna, Johnson and Norval were understandably delighted with the biggest win of their careers so far. "It's going to take quite a few days for this to sink in," said

Norval. "I see this as a fifth major, and it was my dream to win a major in my career."

Johnson revealed

that a major incentive during the week had been his partner's travel arrangements: "Piet made his flight reservations for Monday [after the tournament], so that determined how we would do here this week."

Just as at the Tennis Masters Cup Lisboa, the final in Bangalore was a repeat of a round robin encounter with the loser of the first

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DOHA PREVIEW

Race Ready for Doha Start

The desert hospitality offered at the Qatar Exxon Mobil Open, as well as the superb facilities, have long made the Doha tournament a favorite stop for players and spectators on the ATP circuit.

However, the advent of the Champions Race, which will begin for the second time in the first week of the New Year has added a new dimension to the tournament. As

showed last year, victory in Doha not only brings a prestigious title, but with it also the leadership of the Race.

Santoro, therefore, will be extremely eager

to defend his title on the hard Rebound Ace courts, while 2000 runner-up Rainer Schuettler will desperately want to recapture the title he won as a qualifier in 1999.

Top seed Yevgeny Kafelnikov always performs well on the slow hard courts that suit his all-round game, and Marcelo Rios will be hoping that Doha can mark a return to winning ways after two injury-plagued seasons.

Moroccans always are assured of a warm welcome in Qatar, a factor

which the duo of Karim Alami and Hicham Arazi will be hoping to turn to their advantage, as countryman Younes El Aynaoui did last year on his way to the semifinals.

World No. 1 **Gustavo Kuerten** met Fernando Henrique Cardoso, the President of Brazil last week. Mr Cardoso presented Guga with a shirt bearing the words 'Arrombasi Guga,' which loosely translates to 'Guga Rules.' "We have been trying to meet and now we finally did it," said Kuerten. "I felt really honored and happy about meeting him and I loved the shirt. I wasn't really expecting something like that."

For the second year running **Gustavo Kuerten** was named Brazil's Best Athlete and Brazil's Best Tennis Player by the country's Olympic Committee. The top three candidates were first selected by the public on the internet, and then voted

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match turning the tables in the final. The Indians had defeated Johnson and Norval 6-4, 6-4 on Thursday, but were no match for their opponents in the final. "Playing Mahesh and Leander in the round robin definitely helped us," said Johnson. "The crowd showed us what to expect. The Indians came out firing, but we weathered the storm and when we won the tie-break, they dropped off a bit."

The eventual champions struggled in their semifinal against the Swedish pairing of Simon Aspelin and Johan Landsberg, and at one stage were a break down in the final set.

The experience was ultimately a positive one for Johnson and Norval, however, as the semifinal was played at

3 p.m. in the afternoon sunshine, the same time as the final the following day. By contrast, Bhupathi and Paes had played all their matches under floodlights, and said after the final that they had difficulty adjusting to the brighter conditions.

"It made a difference playing at 3.00 p.m.," said Paes. "The quality wasn't there because we couldn't see the ball."

In their first year playing together, Johnson and Norval had won three titles (Estoril, Nottingham and Basel), and reached two finals (Tennis Masters Series Stuttgart and Toulouse). They were seeded fifth in Bangalore, but had showed good form recently in the indoor season and were confident going into the event.

For Bhupathi and Paes, who had played together only sporadically this year and claimed one title (Tokyo), defeat was a disap-

pointment. "I apologize to our fans here," said Paes. "We could have played better, but I think the superior team won in the end. However, our journey back to the top has begun. It should all come together in the year 2001." They finish the ATP Team Race in 24th position, while Johnson and Norval end in 11th place.

It was an eventful week in India that saw the original alternates for the event Simon Aspelin and Johan Landsberg surpass all expectations to go undefeated in the round robin and reach the semifinals.

Meanwhile, top seeds Ellis Ferreira and

Rick Leach recovered from a slow start to secure a semifinal spot, before going down to Bhupathi and Paes. It

marked the end of Rick Leach's stellar professional career, which took in over 500 doubles match wins, the No. 1 Doubles Ranking (first attained March 1990) and 40 career doubles titles, including nine Grand Slam men's and mixed doubles titles. The last of these came at the Australian Open this year, when he partnered Ferreira to a titanic 18-16 final set win over Andrew Kratzmann and Wayne Black.

Before heading back to the US to become Assistant Coach at the University of Southern California, where his father is Head Coach, Leach paid tribute to the fans in Bangalore. "It's the most incredible atmosphere I have ever played in front of. What a way to go out. The atmosphere was just electric," Leach told the crowd after his final match. "I've had 14 wonderful years. What a treat to play in Bangalore for my last tournament."

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Race Set for New Start in India

With the players preparing to begin their ATP Champions Race 2001 campaign, the Gold Flake Open in Chennai is one of three stops in the first week of the ATP circuit which begins on January 1.

Jerome Golmard, who won his second career title so impressively 12 months ago with a three-set victory over Markus Hantschk in the final, faces a series of threats if he is going to make a successful defense of his crown.

The Frenchman, who finished the year at No. 43, will be alongside Magnus Norman in the 32 draw in India, the Swede who won five titles in 2000 and finished at No. 4 in the ATP Champions Race.

Norman, the top seed in Chennai, will be the man to beat as he attempts to continue his presence in the Top 10 Leader Board, a

claim he maintained every week during the 2000 campaign.

Among the other contenders hoping to get their season off to a winning start will be

Tennis Masters Series Monte Carlo champion Cedric Pioline together with New Balls Please stars Juan Carlos Ferrero and Andreas Vinciguerra.

Ferrero, who clinched Spain's first ever Davis Cup by defeating Lleyton Hewitt in the fourth rubber in Barcelona, will be seeking his

second career title (Mallorca, 1999).

Indian hopes will rest on Leander Paes, the 27-year-old who reached the final of the Gold Flake/ATP Tour World Doubles Championship with Mahesh Bhupathi. The duo also have won the Chennai doubles crown for the last three years.

ADELAIDE PREVIEW

Stars Hope for Prosperous New Year

The thrilling climax to the inaugural ATP Champions Race may still be fresh in the memory, but it will be back to business for the men's circuit in the first week of the New Year in Adelaide. What happened last season counts for nothing as everyone starts the second Race afresh with no points, so the incentive of a Top 10 spot is there for all.

Lleyton Hewitt, Magnus Norman and Thomas Enqvist all showed last year that getting out of the blocks quickly in Adelaide can be a great springboard

for the rest of the season. With hometown hero Hewitt unable to defend the title he has already won twice, colorful Australian Andrew Ilie could be the man to replace him as crowd favorite. Jason Stoltenberg, a finalist in 1998, and Wayne Arthurs may have something to say about that, though.

Top seed Tim Henman will spearhead the

British challenge as he aims to improve on last year's tenth place finish in the Champions Race, while Davis Cup colleague Greg Rusedski will be looking to begin an injury-free year on the right foot. As Rusedski looks to significantly better his

2000 Champions Race performance, French pair Arnaud Clement and Sebastien Grosjean will be hoping to build on excellent results last year which took them to 18th and 19th respectively in the final Race table.

For one player, though, just playing in Adelaide will represent a

major achievement, as Felix Mantilla returns to the circuit after a prolonged absence through injury. The Spaniard spoke recently at his frustration at being unable to even fight for a place on his nation's victorious Davis Cup team, so he perhaps more than anyone will hope that this tournament marks the start of something new.

The ATP Entry System, used for tournament entry and seedings, also came into operation on January 1, 2000.
