ATP CHAMPIONS RACE 2002 LEADER BOARD

No. 1 Hewitt Wins ATP Champions Race 2002 and Tennis Masters Cup

Lleyton Hewitt successfully defended his Tennis Masters Cup title and finished as the year-end World No. 1 for the second consecutive season. The 21-year-old Australian finished 218 points ahead of Andre Agassi in second position after winning his fifth title of the season, and became only the seventh man in the history of the ATP rankings to finish consecutive years at No. 1. A player's ATP Champions Race position is based on points received from the four Grand Slams, nine Tennis Masters Series tournaments, and his best five results from International Series events. The Tennis Masters Cup counted as an additional 19th tournament for the players who qualified.

RACE TO NO. 1

Hewitt Claims Year-End No.1

Lleyton Hewitt joined elite company in Shanghai Thursday night when he became just the seventh player in the history of the ATP rankings to finish year-end No.1 for two consecutive seasons. Andre Agassi's third-set tie-break loss to Juan Carlos Ferrero in round-robin play - which ended Agassi's chances of reaching the semifinals - meant that Hewitt could not be displaced from first place in the ATP Champions Race 2002.

Hewitt was presented with the ATP Champions Race trophy by ATP CEO Mark Miles in a ceremony on center court after his round-robin victory against Marat Safin. Hewitt joins Pete Sampras (6), Jimmy Connors (5), John McEnroe (4), Ivan Lendl (3), Stefan Edberg (2) and Bjorn Borg (2) to finish No.1 in back-to-back seasons. Hewitt is the fourth player to rank No. 1 for every week in the ATP Entry System during the calendar year, joining Connors (1975-76), Lendl (1986-87) and Sampras (1997).

Hewitt also secured the No.1 ranking in the round-robin stage of the Tennis Masters Cup last year when he defeated countryman Patrick Rafter in his third round-robin match.

"I'm over the moon to get this wonderful trophy again," said Hewitt. "Only six other players have won No. 1 in two straight years. I'm honored to be up there with them...I know Pete Sampras has said a lot of the time that it's a lot harder to hold the No. 1 position and there's no doubt about that. But I think this has been fantastic and it's been special in a lot of ways, just because I've led this year, I guess, for most of it, especially since Wimbledon and I've been able to hold No. 1 for the whole year.

Mark Miles said: "Last year Lleyton cemented his place in history as the youngest year-end No.1 in the history of our sport. This year he has headed the ATP Champions Race every week since winning Wimbledon and, in an incredible achievement, joins only six other players who have been No.1 in consecutive seasons."

World No. 1 Hewitt Claims Back-to-Back Tennis Masters Cup Crowns

Lleyton Hewitt confirmed his status as a deserving back-to-back year-end World No.1 by winning a dramatic five-set final against Juan Carlos Ferrero at the Tennis Masters Cup Shanghai.

After seeing a two-sets lead slip away, Hewitt was forced to claw back from 1-3 in the fifth set to win 7-5, 7-5, 2-6, 2-6, 6-4 and defend the title he won last year in Sydney.

Hewitt's victory was played before a capacity crowd of 9,500 at the New Shanghai International Expo Center, with appreciative Chinese fans bursting into several Mexican Waves throughout the match.

It was Hewitt's fifth title of the year and his first since Wimbledon in early July. He went the distance in all the four matches he played at the Tennis Masters Cup, defeating Albert Costa and Marat Safin in three sets in the round-robin group, Roger Federer in three sets in the semifinals, and Ferrero in five sets in the final. His one loss against Carlos Moya

in the round-robin stage was in straight sets. Both finalists played eight sets in two days, with Ferrero having also taken three sets to beat Moya in Saturday's semifinals.

During round-robin play, Hewitt became just the seventh player in ATP history to finish the year No.1 in consecutive seasons after Andre Agassi, the only man who could catch him, failed to reach the semifinals. By winning the Tennis Masters Cup, Hewitt also became the first player since Pete Sampras (ATP World Championships, 1996-97) to win the season-ending championship in consecutive years.

Hewitt, who defeated Ferrero the last time they met in the semifinals of Tennis Masters Cup Sydney, ensured that the year-end World No.1 won the Tennis Masters Cup for the third consecutive year (Gustavo Kuerten triumphed at Tennis Masters Cup Lisboa in 2000, claiming the No.1 ranking when he defeated Andre Agassi in the final).

Hewitt takes home a check for \$1.4 million and also drives away in a new Mercedes-Benz CLK320.

In a gripping final, Ferrero began strongly and claimed a 5-3 lead. But Hewitt reeled off seven consecutive games to take the first set 7-5 and set up a decisive lead in the second set, which he would go on to win. Ferrero hit back with a double break in the third set, which he took 6-2, and repeated the dose in the fourth set. Ferrero had the advantage at the beginning of the fifth set when, after three consecutive breaks, he led 2-1. But Hewitt made it four breaks in six games when he leveled the set at 3-3. Soon after he broke Ferrero at 5-4 to claim victory.

Despite the loss, Ferrero ends the season in fourth place in the ATP Champions Race – his highest year-end ranking. He finished fifth last season and is the first Spaniard since Sergi Bruguera in 1993-94 to finish in the Top 5 in back-to-back seasons.

What the Players Said:

Lleyton Hewitt: "It's fantastic. It's been another very special week not only in my tennis career, but in my life in general. My goal was coming here to get this one to my left [ATP Champions Race trophy] and once that passed, then obviously I tried to put everything into regaining focus and desire and motivation to come out and win the Masters Cup and defend it again. It's not the easiest thing to do when you're playing against the other seven best players in the world. In my opinion, probably anyone in the tournament could have won it.

"Every match this week was a grind – I didn't have one easy match. Obviously the Costa match was... I wasn't playing as well as I would have liked to have been, but you want to play yourself into the tournament as well. The Moya match, I felt like I played pretty well in that match and got beaten by a better player and had a lot of chances. Safin, Federer and Ferrero – it doesn't get much tougher than those three matches. I think maybe a couple of three-hour matches and a four-hour match nearly. I don't know how I held up at all, considering the way that I have been feeling the last few weeks. I can put my feet up and go on holidays. It'll be great. Can't wait."

Juan Carlos Ferrero: "Right now, I don't feel very happy, but if I'm thinking in the year I have to be happy because I didn't start the year well with the injuries and right now I finish the year really good playing good tennis in the final here in Masters. Seeing the whole year, I'm really happy. Looking at the whole week, I feel really good – just lost two matches. I played really good against very good players. So it is the first final for me. I have to be happy.

"I had 5-3 in the first set and then I lost 7-5, I think, in the second, he took the advantage, but I came back with good tennis again. I started to play with more accuracy with my forehand and then in the fifth set, everybody knows the story. He's a tough guy; he didn't make a lot of mistakes. I took a 3-1 lead, but finally I lost the match.

France Makes Final Preparations

The Davis Cup final begins on November 29 at the Palais Omnisports in Paris Bercy with Russia hoping to claim its first ever title against a French team bidding to defend the Cup it won 12 months ago in Melbourne.

Russian captain Shamil Tarpishev already has named Marat Safin, Yevgeny Kafelnikov, Mikhail Youzhny and Andrei Stoliarov in his lineup to take on the French, whose captain Guy Forget has until Tuesday to announce his final nominations.

Forget selected Arnaud Clement, Nicolas Escude, Sebastien Grosjean, Paul-Henri Mathieu and Fabrice Santoro to attend a training camp at the Roc Garden Tennis Club in Royan on Sunday November 17, although there was no place for Michael Llodra, who played doubles with Santoro in the quarterfinal and semifinal victories over the Czech Republic and United States, respectively.

Mathieu, who has not played competitively since winning back-to-back titles in Moscow and Lyon in October, has been suffering from an abdominal injury but was cleared to attend by team doctor Bernard Montalvan.

Escude, Grosjean, Clement and Santoro all were on the winning team that defeated Australia on grass in last year's final in Melbourne, while Grosjean and Santoro have appeared in all three victories en route to this year's final.

For Safin, Youzhny and Stoliarov on the Russian team – which who recorded wins over Switzerland, Sweden and Argentina to reach its first final since 1995 – it will be their first appearance in a Davis Cup final.

Safin, who lost all three of his matches at the Tennis Masters Cup in Shanghai last week, will have to put the disappointment behind him before going to Paris, where he won the BNP Paribas Masters at the Palais Omnisports last month. And the 21-year-old from Moscow certainly is hoping his team will be able to taste victory after suffering two successive final defeats in against Sweden in 1994 and the United States in 1995.

"That was very disappointing to lose two finals in Moscow," said Safin. "But now it's the third time in the final for Russia and, although the conditions will be tough away from home, there is a chance. In Russia I have everyone with me. In Paris I will have most of the people against me. That's life. Especially in Davis Cup. It's a team sport."

Kafelnikov, who played in both of those finals in 1994-95, has made no secret of his desire to hang up his racquets should Russia win the Cup. And the 28-year-old believes the choice of an indoor clay court could go some way to helping him and the team realize their dream.

"I don't say [the French] made a big mistake, but definitely by choosing the clay they completely equalize the chances to both teams, I think," said Kafelnikov, who added: "Marat [Safin] has been very helpful to me throughout this year. He understands that this is important to me."

The last time the two nations played was back in 1983, when the French team emerged as 4-1 winners in a World Group first round encounter in Moscow. France has won the Davis Cup nine times in total, and a 10th will put the French team in third position in the all-time winners list behind the U.S.A (31) and Australia (27).

Limited numbers of the inaugural issue of *DEUCE* – featuring an artist's illustration of tennis great Andre Agassi on the cover and a fashion spread showcasing 2002 sensation James Blake – can still be purchased from ATPtennis.com.

"I think Lleyton obviously has had a great year. He's again proven himself to be the best out there and that's not easy to do, especially the way he plays the game. So a lot of credit to him...I approach next year with the expectation of it being better. That's a good feeling. I got behind the eight ball this year with the Australian and my wrist and turned it around and felt like I got myself a few opportunities for some special moments." – **Andre Agassi** reflecting on another great year in which he won five titles, and looking ahead to 2003.

"I felt like it was probably one of the gutsiest efforts that I've ever played in against tonight, to come back against Marat the way that he finished off the second and the way that he started the third, that's as well as anyone has ever hit the ball I've ever seen." – **Lleyton Hewitt** after defeating **Marat Safin** in three closely fought sets to reach the semifinals of the Tennis Masters Cup.

"At the beginning of the year, did I think I would be here? Well, I didn't think that after Australia, where I played really bad, I didn't know where I was. I knew I was practicing really well, practicing hard and I was in good shape. I was fit, healthy, but my tennis wasn't there. I think the turning point was in Acapulco. I would say that gave me a lot of confidence to win that tournament and since then, I started to play really well and hit the ball well." – **Carlos Moya**, who won four titles in 2002, on where it all began to turn around for him.

"I'm the same player as two months ago on hard court, but finally I could play my tennis, my good tennis on this surface. I'm really happy for that and I hope that in the next year I'm going to try to give my best also in hard court, not only in this tournament." – **Juan Carlos Ferrero**, looking forward to a good hard court season in 2003.

"Looks like it. I've played him nine times, he beat me seven of them, so it looks like he's not my favorite player." – **Moya** on whether he finds it hard to play against **Ferrero** after losing to his countryman in the semifinals.

"It was one of the best matches in my career because I think that Andre Agassi is one of the best players in history. I played four times against him and I never won a set so I was, until the end of the match, pretty scared about my victory. I'm still living like a dream, because I just qualified in the last days. It is amazing for me I am part of this team. The best eight players in the world and I'm very happy that I reach for the first time the Masters tournament and I'm just trying to fight and I'm just trying to play my best tennis." – **Jiri Novak** after defeating **Andre Agassi** in the round-robin stages in Shanghai.

"It's definitely a step forward. It was a great experience for me to live through this Masters Cup event and I'm pleasantly surprised by the event. It's been unbelievable organization. I enjoyed the city and the people here were very nice to me, so it was a great week for me and I will always remember this." – Semifinalist **Roger Federer** on his first Tennis Masters Cup experience.
